Please read and initial each item below confirming that you have read and understand the Festival Rules

Initial

Vendor space is limited to 10 ft. x 10 ft. The location of your space will be determined by the Grounds Committee. You are responsible to provide your own tables, tent, chair, etc.

Festival hours are as follows:

Friday 5/29/26 - 5 pm to 11 pm (your setup must be completed by 4pm)

Saturday 5/30/26 - 12 pm to midnight

Sunday 5/31/26 - 12 pm to 6 pm

Your booth must be **completely set up by 4pm on Thursday** prior to the start of the festival. We are offering an option for Day-before setup which will be permitted on Thursday 5/28/26 starting at 5pm.

Closing times are approximate – you may close your station when you feel that your sales are done for the day.

All sales must take place from your assigned booth space. No roving sales are permitted.

Smoking is NOT permitted at the vendor stations. All vendors, customers and guests must step away from the vendor station if they wish to smoke.

Vendors should use the dumpsters provided on the festival grounds to discard boxes and trash.

Vendor fees for the entire 3-day festival are **\$150**. Fees are **not** refundable due to inclement weather. Deadline for vendor application and fees is **Wednesday, May 20, 2026**.

Each vendor shall comply with all festival rules, local laws, and regulations.

All applications are subject to approval by the Greek Festival committee.
